Recently, a team of 34 Gore High School runners took part in the Milton Relay. After recent rain the underfoot conditions were remarkably good and the weather on the day was perfect.

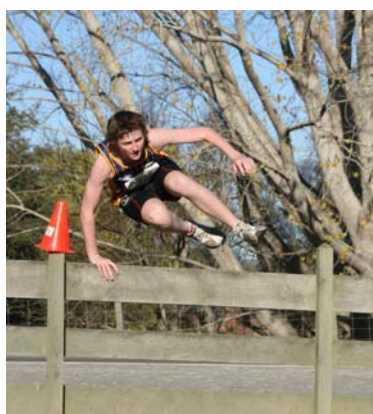
- The two junior boys teams achieved 4th and 7th with Brad Catto having a best time of 6:58.
